Prof. Joann Trzeciak Huss from Kent University, an expert in translation theory, gender studies, race, literary translation, and world literature, visited the English department of Faculty of Education and Humanities at International Burch University as a guest lecturer to speak about collaborative translation in the age of machine translation. Guiding us through some of the modern notions in collaborative translation as well as approaches she relied on as a researcher in the field, prof.
